This can be on arrival or as you leave. The barrier will rise to let you out of the car park because your number will be recognised.

Due to reduced parking spaces at the Church please park at Heathside (details of free Sunday parking above) or the side roads around the Church, so that those with mobility problems (and first time visitors) are still able to use the Church car park. During the week after 11.30 am and all day on Sundays you may park in the side roads around the Church on single yellow lines and in parking boxes.
